Woodbine Horse People,

In an effort to ensure the highest quality racing possible here at Woodbine Racetrack, we will be increasing our surveillance efforts and security presence on the backstretch in the following manner:

- Surveillance of the stalls of horses in to go on race day.
- Surveillance will begin at 5 am and continue until the horse is in the Paddock.
- Logs will be maintained recording the identity of anyone entering a stall and observations of anything that may be given to the horse or applied to the horse. Vets may be asked to provide information on treatment.
- This program will be conducted under the authority of rule 6.34 of the WEG track rules.

Ensuring the quality and integrity of our racing product remains one of Woodbine's primary objectives. Woodbine will continue to make this a top priority as having a quality product with the highest level of integrity benefits all within the Woodbine thoroughbred horse racing community.
